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Milorad M. Novicevic (Ph.D. University of Oklahoma) is an Associate Professor of Management at the University of Mississippi. His research and teaching interests are in the management history, leadership and ethics, management education, and international management areas. He currently serves as the Editorial Board member for the *Journal of Leadership and Organization Studies* and *Journal of Management History*.
